Daily Reading

He did the will of his Father, and took no thought for the morrow, after He became a man. He feared nothing for Himself, and never once employed His divine power to save Himself from His human fate. Let God do that for Him if He saw fit. To fall back on Himself, God failing Him – that would be to declare heaven void. And the world without a God.
